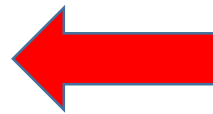

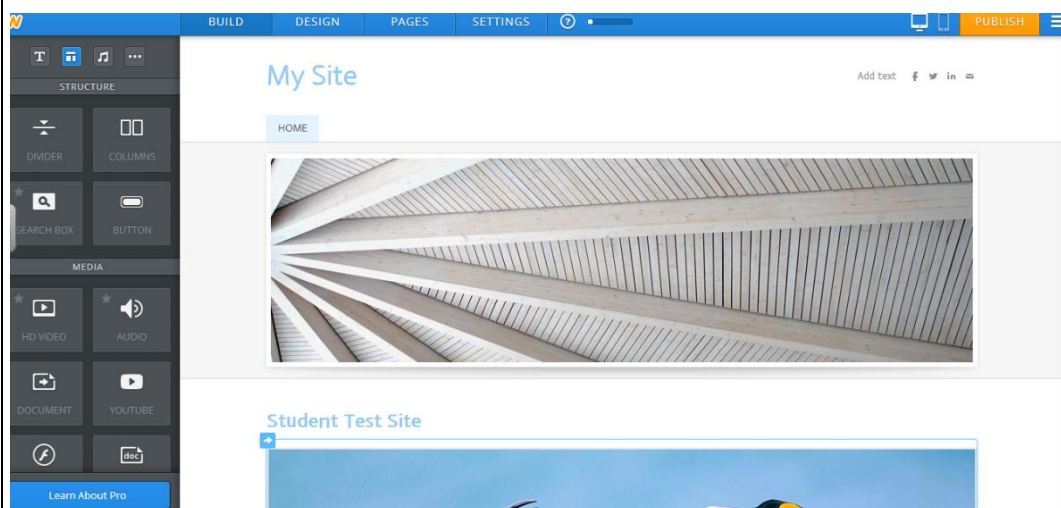

9. Students will log in with the username and class password that the teacher has created.

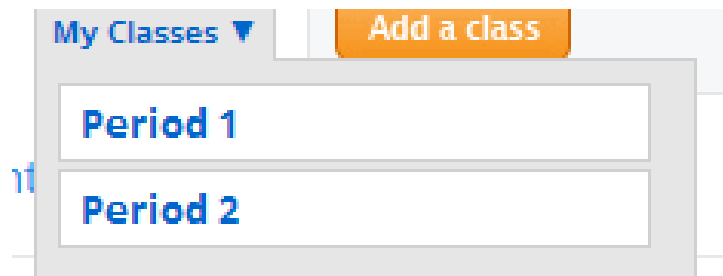

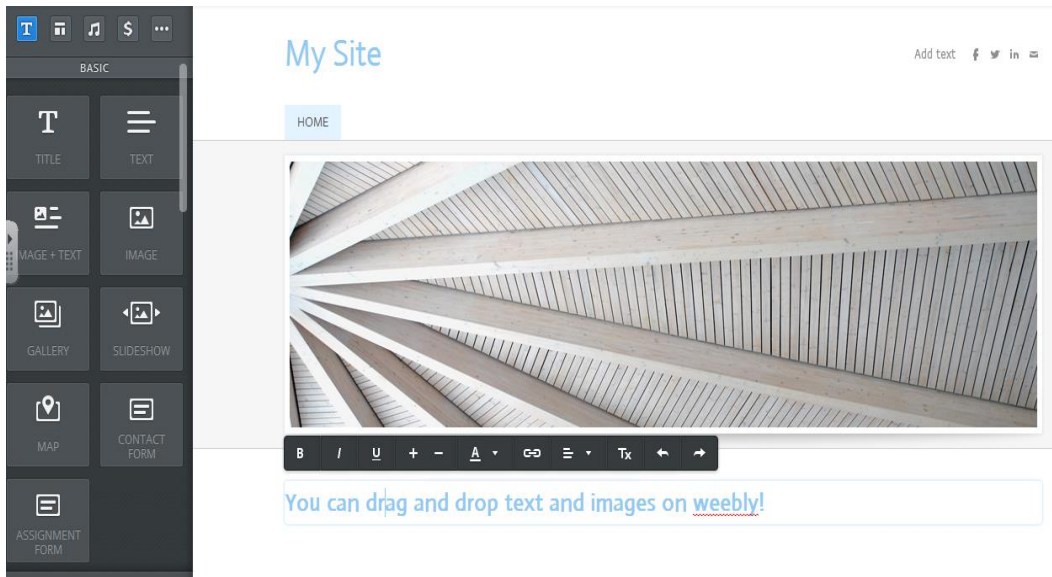
